In 1948, a group of farmers in Southland formed Alliance Freezing Company Limited to process and market high-quality meat and co-products to international markets. The first processing plant, and still our largest, was opened in Lorneville, in 1960, and in 1980 the company's ownership structure changed to become a co-operative. Today, Alliance Group proudly remains New Zealand's only 100% farmer-owned red meat co-operative.

As guardians of the land, our farmers respect and value the environment. They are committed to taking care of the soil, water and land so they can pass their farms onto future generations. 



You'll spend the first eight months based in one of our seven plants working across the entire Plant Operations before moving into Livestock as we enter the warmer months to finish off the year. In the New Year, you'll join our Sales teams for the first six months before choosing where you'd like to base yourself for your final six months within our other corporate and support functions such as Finance, People and Safety, Engineering, IT or Technical.
